Join us for this Women's Retreat on 'Living Intentionally' to be held in Marysville VIC. Our speaker is Dr Anessa Westbrook, from Harding University, Searcy, Arkansas, USA.

Time & Date: 6.00pm Friday 23 June – 4.00 pm Saturday 24 June, 2017

Venue: El Kanah, Marysville VIC (a beautiful guest house and chapel 90 min northeast of Melbourne – www.elkanahmarysville.org.au)

Anessa will lead us through four lessons to help us grow spiritually as we focus on living 'intentional lives'. The first session begins after dinner on Friday evening and there are three sessions on Saturday (9.30am – 4.00pm). Saturday morning will start with a devotional and time for worship in the little chapel on the El Kanah grounds.

To make transport easier, Belmore Rd Church of Christ will provide a bus and driver at no cost – leaving from their building (100 Rostrevor Pde, Mont Albert North) at 3.30pm on Fri and returning to the building at the conclusion of the Retreat (arriving ~5.45 pm Sat).

Cost for the Retreat (includes lodging Friday night and all meals on Sat)

- Single room occupancy (queen bed & ensuite) - \$185 per person
- Double room occupancy (adult single beds & ensuite) - \$115 per person
- Triple room occupancy (adult single beds & ensuite) - \$95 per person
- Quad room occupancy – limited # (adult single beds & ensuite) - \$95 per person

Each lady will be responsible for their dinner costs for Friday evening (\$35).

A day-conference rate is available for \$40 for those who come for Saturday only.
